Wine Tasting Planning Guide



If you're heading out on a wine tasting excursion, there are a few planning tips to keep in mind to enhance your wine tasting experience for maximum enjoyment.



Plan Your Itinerary

- Choose two to three tasting rooms or wineries
- Plan a multi-day tasting focusing on select American Viticultural Areas each day if possible
- Select winery locations and visiting order to minimize driving time
- Review the expected tasting time on each winery's website to give yourself enough time
- Set time aside for lunch or dinner

Booking Your Reservation

- Book your reservation two to four weeks ahead of time
- If you'd like to walk-in, ensure your selected wineries are not by-appointment-only tastings

Do Your Research

- Look to see if your selected tasting rooms and wineries have tasting fees
- Check if your selected wineries have minimum purchase requirements
